

Using the “Perseus Collection”

NT Hapax Legomenon (ex. 1 Tim. 2:12)

1. Open your SESB NA27 (or a NA27 Greek text) Bible and navigate to 1 Tim 2:12.
2. Right click the word ἀθεντεῖν.
3. Select Lemma and then “Bible Word Study”.
4. When the Word Study Completes you will notice that that word root only occurs 1 time in the entire New Testament and not at all in the LXX (as the “Septuagint Translation” section will be greyed out)
5. Scroll to the very bottom of the word study and expand the section titled “TEXTUAL SEARCHES”

- a. In the past this would show you only “New Testament” and the “LXX” with a hit count.
- b. Now there are 3 options
 - i. New Testament
 - ii. LXX
 - iii. Classics (This section was not there for my before Perseus)

BUT WHAT IS SO COOL?? There are 13 classical references to the root in Perseus! For a word that only occurs one time in the entire Greek New Testament!

6. Click on “Classics” and you can see where and how in the Perseus Greek Resources the word is used.
